

York and District Road Race League

Constitution

1. (a) The name of the League is “York and District Road Race League”
(Hereafter called the “League”).
(b) The committee shall be formed of two representatives from each of the member clubs
2. The object of the League is to organise a series of Road Races in York and surrounding area, at low cost and open only to England Athletics clubs who have ben admitted to the League. Any applications from other clubs wanting to join the league will be reviewed at the agm.
3. The income and property of the League shall be used for the promotion of the league and also at the League committee’s discretion.
4. Each member club in the League shall have an equal share of the assets and losses (see 5)
5. Should a member club decide to withdraw from the League it forfeits it’s share of the assets.
6. If upon disbanding of the League, there remain any assets after debts, these are to be divided among the remaining member clubs. All clubs must agree to the disbanding of the league.
7. The liability of all clubs in the League will be equal to and limited to the total assets within the League
8. True accounts shall be kept and at least once a year these must be made available to all member clubs.
9. Every year after the League an Annual General Meeting must be called (see 10)
10. At the A.G.M. all officials of the League will be elected. Twenty-eight days’ notice must be given in writing including an agenda
11. Each club to have only two representatives at the A.G.M. Each member club has one vote.
12. Any alteration to the constitution and the League Race Rules requires a majority of member clubs in favour.
13. The officers of the League to be a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary, who may be in addition to the two club representatives.
14. All cheques to carry two signatures
15. The League to abide by the laws of UK Athletics.
